THE COLORS, FLAGS AND AUTOMOBILE PLATE FOR THE DEPUTY SECRETARY OF DEFENSE WILL BE OF THE SAME DESIGN AND MATERIAL AS THOSE FOR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE EXCEPT THAT THE FLAG BASE WILL BE WHITE, AND THE STARS AND FRINGE WILL BE MEDIUM BLUE.

DEPUTY SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

DESIGN APPROVED BY THE PRESIDENT 16 AUGUST 1949.

THE COLORS, FLAGS AND AUTOMOBILE PLATE FOR THE ASSISTANT SECRETARIES OF DEFENSE WILL BE OF THE SAME DESIGN AND MATERIAL AS THOSE FOR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE EXCEPT THAT THE FLAG BASE WILL BE WHITE, AND THE STARS AND FRINGE WILL BE RED. (CABLE No. 80108 OLD GLORY).

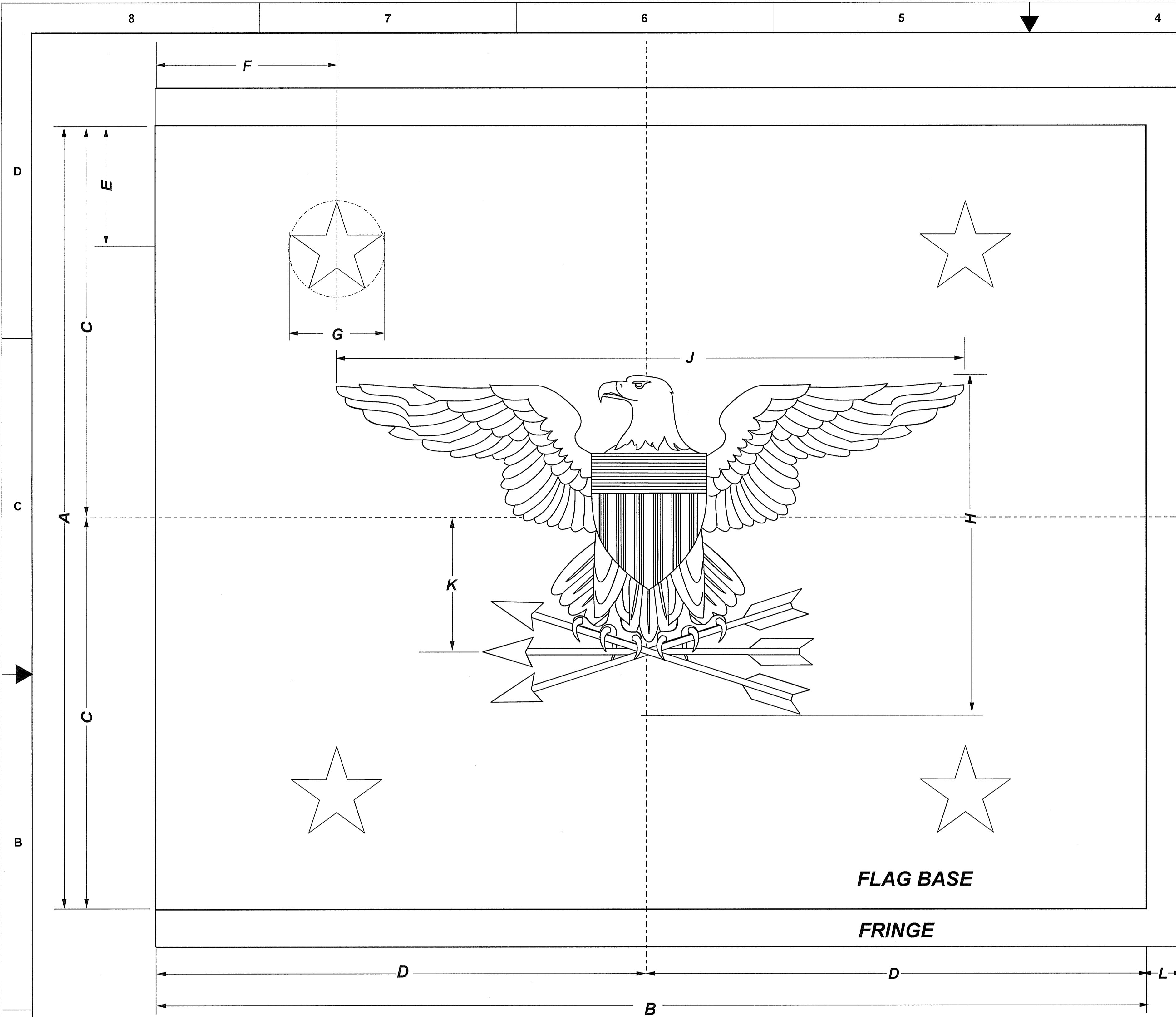

THE COLORS, FLAGS AND AUTOMOBILE PLATE FOR PAS WILL BE OF THE SAME DESIGN, MATERIAL AND COLORS AS THOSE FOR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE EXCEPT THAT THE FLAG BASE WILL BE WHITE, AND THE STARS AND FRINGE WILL BE OLD GLORY BLUE. (CABLE No. 80075). THESE OFFICIALS INCLUDE:

- TO BE MANUFACTURED IN ACCORDANCE WITH LATEST REVISION OF SPECIFICATION MIL-DTL-2692.
 - DEVICE AND STARS SHALL APPEAR AS ILLUSTRATED ON BOTH SIDES OF THE FLAG.
 - ALL DIMENSIONS ARE EXCLUSIVE OF HEADING AND HEMS.
 - FOR RAYON BANNER CLOTH FLAGS, DEVICE AND STARS TO BE EMBROIDERY.
 - NYLON FLAG: ENTIRE FLAG SHALL BE SCREEN PRINTED UTILIZING PENETRATING DYES. COLORS ON THE OBTVERSE SIDE SHALL BE A GOOD MATCH TO THOSE SPECIFIED. A SLIGHT CHANGE OF COLOR WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE REVERSE SIDE.
- SCREEN PRINTING SHALL BE DONE WITH SCREENS MADE BY THE PHOTOGRAPHIC METHOD AND COLORS SEPARATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH COLOR GUIDE DRAWING.
- BASE CLOTH SHALL BE LIGHTWEIGHT NYLON CONFORMING TO TYPE I, CLASS A OF SPECIFICATION CCC-C-476.
