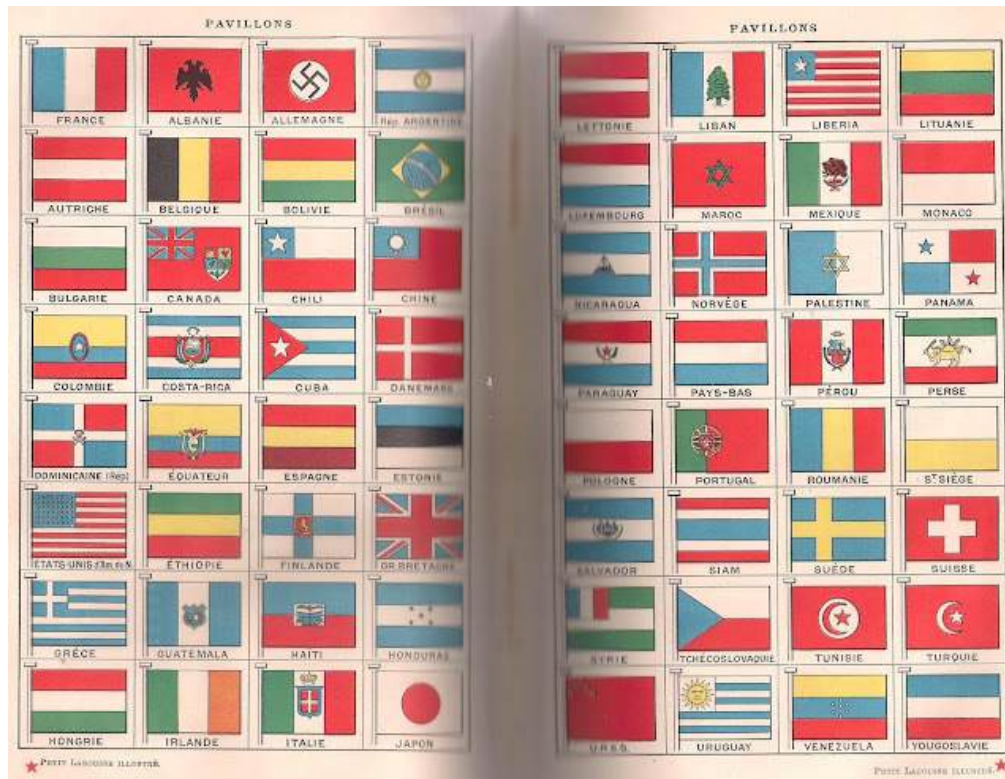

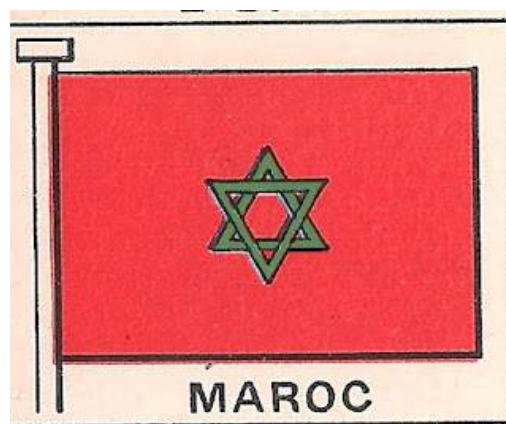
1938 PALESTINE FLAG

1938 PALESTINE FLAG ON LAROUSSE



It is a French Larousse dictionary of 1938. In the annex, all the flags then in force in the world are repertoires in alphabetical order. You will notice that for Germany at that time the official flag was the

flag of the Nazi wearing the Awastika, which proves that it was between 1933 and 1945 (before the end of the Second World War).). Now, in alphabetical order, look for the Palestinian flag. Yes, there is one. What does this look like? Surprised? Oh, but you thought (Jewish mosquito) that Palestine is an Islamic, Arab, Turkish, Circassian and sovereign state? France's position is very equivocal at this time.



From 1920 to 1948, a State in Palestine (Mandat Class "A") existed under international law but was established, like all its main institutions, by Jews. Until the 1960s, the name "Palestine" resonated as something Jewish in the ears of peoples. The Jewish homeland of 4000 years or "Land of Israel" or "Holy Land" were all synonymous. The British as Legal Mandatory on the Mandate managed or mismanaged the state partially with the Jewish Auxiliary until the Jews regained official sovereignty in 1948, declaring independence. The United Nations recreated Israel by the vote of 33 nations. The mandate of Palestine for the establishment of a Jewish national homeland.

Another mistake slipped into this board, namely the flag of Morocco. At that time Morocco was still under a French protectorate until 1956. But on this flag it's the aile of David and not the cherifian star. I have seen in other editions that the correction was made. It points out that Mohamed 5, King of Morocco during the Second World War, refused to apply the laws of Vichy and would be exiled to Madagascar.
