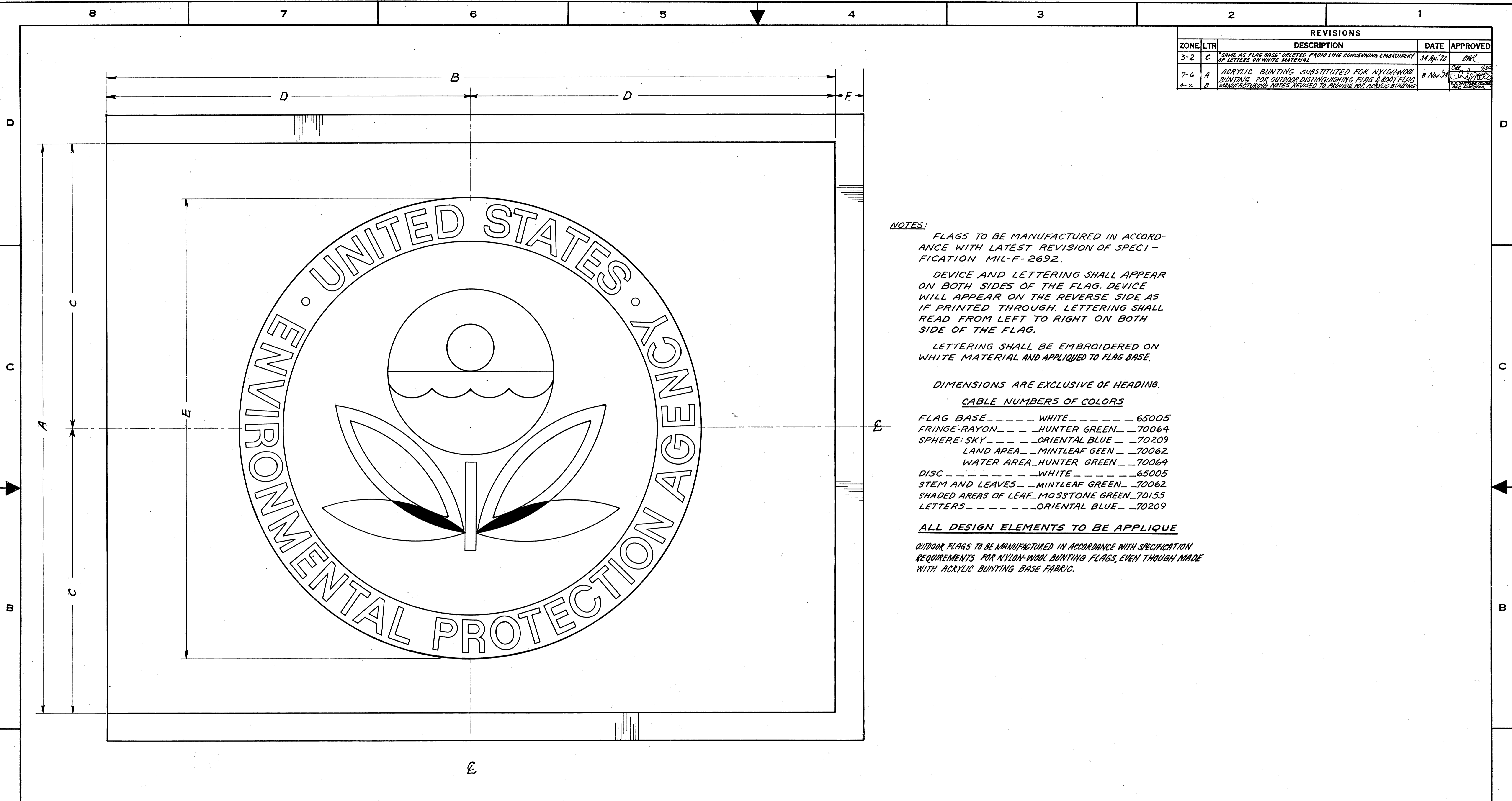

DEVICE AND LETTERING SHALL APPEAR ON BOTH SIDES OF THE FLAG. DEVICE WILL APPEAR ON THE REVERSE SIDE AS IF PRINTED THROUGH. LETTERING SHALL READ FROM LEFT TO RIGHT ON BOTH SIDE OF THE FLAG.

LETTERING SHALL BE EMBROIDERED ON WHITE MATERIAL AND APPLIED TO FLAG BASE.

DIMENSIONS ARE EXCLUSIVE OF HEADING.
